I will never get tired of reading this series. It's suspenseful, engaging, emotional, and full of

adrenaline-pumping action. Andrew Klavan's writing style is the best that I've ever read (and I've read a lot of books)! Charlie West is one of the best fictional characters ever! He's so loyal, honest, and brave. I already own this series, I actually bought this copy for a friend (she loves it!)! I couldn't pass up the opportunity to say how much I love this series. Suspense and adventure dominate this series. At times it seemed a bit tedious with the main character in yet another desperate situation so similar to previous ones, but that may be due to my old age. Some illustrations of the areas where he was held or through which he had to travel to escape would have been nice. It is really good to find a book with characters that stand up for what is right. This is taking place in our current time and is (sadly) all too real in terms of what is happening in our nation. So here is one kid who has an appreciation for our Constitution, for freedom, decency, etc. Young people can learn from this guy.

Very suspenseful and hard to put down. My only problem with them was that it isn't really 4 books in my opinion -- it's 1 very long one!! The first 3 didn't (for me at least) have a satisfactory ending. (That's why I only gave it 4 stars.) I especially liked the patriotism and clean living that the hero portrayed.

While I loved the suspense and general pace of this series of books, it had a few flaws. It was redundant in his memories of home, friends, and especially his girlfriend; it also, at times felt like it was written to pre-teens and at other times used words in ways in which they are not normally used. I have a MA in education and still had to look several up because they were words that didn't seem to fit.
