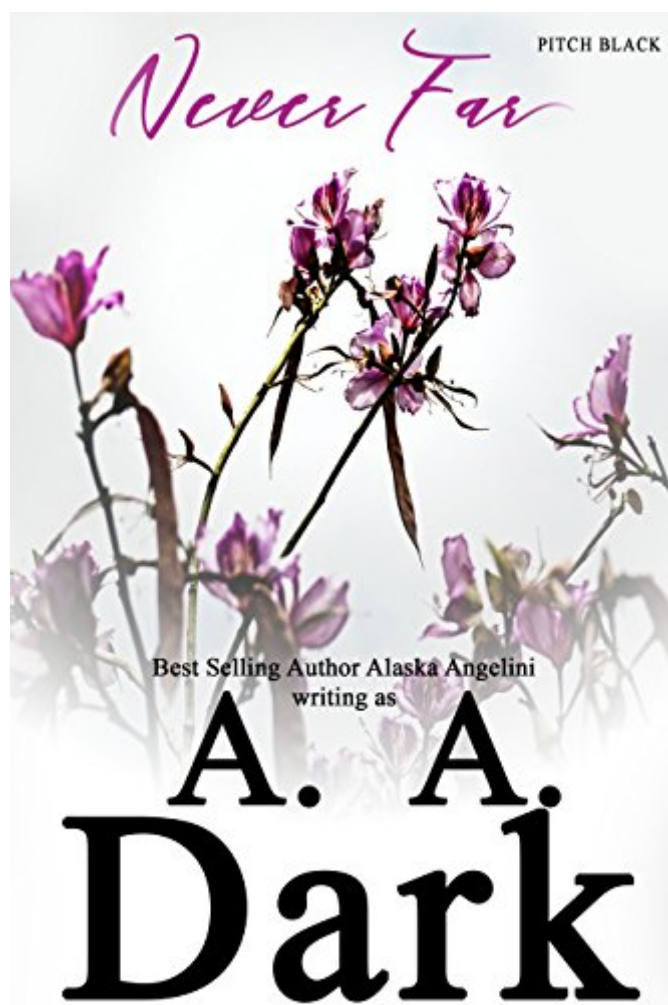


The book was found

Ever feel guilty about liking a hero who is a bad person? I never did until I read this book. The thing is that there are things about Boston that check all my ideal romance hero boxes. Protective?

Check. He would die for her. Obsessed with and crazy in love with the heroine?. Check. He totally is. Felt he could not breathe without her. Made sure that he was in her life from an early age. Faithful? Check. She was his one and only. This book has a forbidden element that will bother some readers. There is an age difference. He is 4 years old older than her and she is only 18 years old when the book starts and he had been obsessing about her for years. Admittedly a totally wrong thing to do given how young she was. But then that is the least wrong thing he does....SOME BUT NOT ALL SPOILER The hero is a killer. He does not kill for profit or revenge. He does not even do it to rid society of evil like Dexter does. Rather before he was with the heroine he killed for fun and since she became his, anyone he sees as standing in his way of being with her no matter how innocent the person is or close of relationship the heroine has with them. Therefore I feel guilty because I was glad that they were together even though he is a bad person. When the book ended he was happy for the first time in his life because he was with her and therefore he fine with not killing anymore. However, I believe that he will in the future when he perceives someone as a threat to their relationship, real or imagined.

Is there such a thing as too dark? I have yet to reach that pinnacle. I do know that A.A. Dark will soothe my appetite for depravity and and immorality! I have her on speed dial on my kindle and get giddy when I hear of a new release from her. If you're in the mood for a dark and dangerous psychopath, this little morsel will quench your thirst. Boston is calculating, manipulative and obsessed. He has a persistent disturbing preoccupation with Lucy which began at a very young age. The need to protect and claim her is ever present, and when the opportunity appears to make her his, he takes full advantage with all his deranged proclivities. I devoured Never Far, the storyline, the characters, the plot were all phenomenal, the psychological component sending it into perverse and devious perfection.

I was looking for something a bit different and wow, this was definitely it! This was a short and easy read so perhaps inevitably, I was left with some unanswered questions. For example, did Dr. Patron and Mrs. Marks understand Boston's plans? What had come between Boston and his father? I also would have liked an epilogue just to make sure Boston and Lily really were happy in the future. I have read a lot of books about criminals but usually they are members of a MC or mafia and not just random serial killers. Despite the unorthodox premise for a romance novel, I found myself rooting for the villainous protagonist! Boston is not really book boyfriend material though since I love my family!

There wasn't a lot to this book. Obsessed guy, naive girl, gaslighting. It's been done before so it wasn't terribly original. It's not very long, so there are no deep dives into the characters - they are cardboard cutouts of characters we have seen in movies and other books - the naive heroine, the overprotective sketchy older brother, the love object from childhood. The graphic violence was more gratuitous than helpful to understanding the killer. Net, if you are an AA fan, I'd probably read it, but otherwise I'd skip it.

While I love romance and comedy, I also enjoy reading the darker more creepy books as well. Never Far is about Boston, his best friend Jeff, and Jeff's sister Lucy. Boston and Jeff were filming a movie when a freak accident happened and Boston ended up in a coma. When he finally wakes up, the only person he remembers is Lucy. Never Far is a suspenseful mind eff that has you turning the page trying to figure out what's going to happen next and what really happened to put the characters where they are. Which character is being truthful and which one is telling a lie? I only wish it was longer. I wanted more detail about the incident in the cabin. I wanted to see more of the characters' past to get a better picture of their friendship. I wanted to see more of Boston and Lucy. I just needed a little more.

Woah. Not sure where to even begin! This book blew my mind. It's not only a suspenseful thriller, it's twists and turns take you on a dark path that leave your heart beating faster than you can imagine. This book isn't for the faint of heart. Expect the unexpected.
