

One of the more engaging horse books about with both a complex and heartfelt story balanced beautifully with loads of wonderful riding and the thrill of competitive jumping. All of the characters are well developed and despite the cheesy title, this book is fairly original, wonderfully written, and well equestrian-ated. The plot is good, and though heartbreaking at parts, there is a realistic and familiar sense of humor. I have read the book "Dare to Dream" and not only recommend this book to those who enjoyed that one (and vice versa) but also love that the author uses the name Skybeau in this one!!! All of the people/ponies are realistically complex and real. All in all, a great equestrian story for all ye horse lovers like myself. I don't come from New Zealand, but from the UK and this book is wonderful. Jay goes through the same emotions I did when moving to the US, if a bit different (thankfully I came with all my family) and the author describes that part beautifully. Learning to live in a new country, dealing with the loss of her mother and getting to know her father, Jay finally finds her way in a world which isn't always easy.
