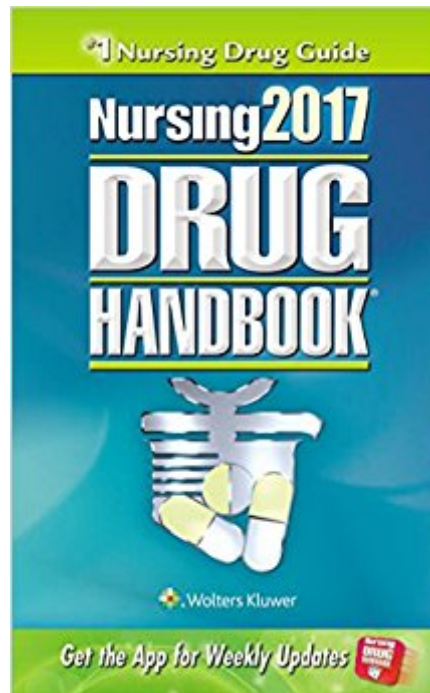

I never leave negative feedback, but I have to make an exception this time. This is a great book in PAPER, but the Kindle edition is too difficult to use. If It doesn't supply the reader with hyperlinks from the Index to the page needed. It also provides page numbers instead of location in the index and if you want to jump from page to page, you must use a location. What I'm trying to say is, if you are trying to find amlodipine, you can search for amlodipine, but you may have to visit 14 different pages until you find the one you are looking for. You also have the option of skimming page by page until you find it.

This is my first drug book and I love it. It is easy to read. I bought it over a pocket size because I just think there is only so much that can be condensed before you miss critical information. I'm a nursing student in my senior year and will definitely use this when working as a nurse. I recommended it to a friend, which did end up buying it as well:)
