

A few things not covered, Perspective Warp and Puppet Warp were two. But the content is helpful and presented in Kelby's inimitable style. It seems all new examples from the CS6 book, so that was nice.

If you have never touched Adobe Camera Raw, or Photoshop...this book is for you!!! If you have used camera raw before, and are looking on how to do more in photoshop like create pop art and other cool images, and do things that are more complex than cropping an image and creating a new layer in photoshop...this book is not for you. Unfortunately for me, I am in the latter section. I took a beginners course in photography earlier this year. We used Adobe Bridge and Camera Raw constantly...the only thing that I used photo shop in that course for was how to dodge and burn an image. So I was hoping that a book titled "PHOTOSHOP for digital photographers..." would actually teach me how to use photoshop and create interesting art with it. Instead I got a twelve chapter book....six of those twelve chapters explaining in depth Adobe Camera Raw, and Bridge....despite the author telling you not to use bridge because Adobe hasn't updated it in a while....one chapter on how to crop and image. And the remaining chapters talking about how to fix portraits so that they are more acceptable for selling. That's it. Nothing neat like creating pop art, or making your image look like it was a sketch or painting. Nope. That is what I would expect a book about photoshop to do...and that is not what I got. I'm returning it for a refund. Waste of money.

What can I say, Scott Kelby is very knowledgeable and makes things easy to understand.

This book has limited value unless you have a thorough knowledge of photoshop.

This is a good basic reference manual for someone just starting to learn Photoshop. If you are looking for a in depth book on Photoshop you may want to keep looking.

Learned more about Camera Raw than I knew existed.

I recently gave in to the inevitable and upgraded from Photoshop Elements (PSE) to Photoshop CC (cloud version). I learned Elements using Scott Kelby's then-current book and have used his books to learn each subsequent PSE release. If you're just starting with Photoshop, Scott's books are a great way to learn. When upgrading from prior PSE releases, I've used Scott's books as not just a way to learn new features, but as a complete refresher course on everything Photoshop can do. (That said, the one improvement I can suggest is a summary or index of new features.) I especially like the way Scott not just explains each feature, but tells the reader how HE uses it (or doesn't use it, but rather uses some other feature or technique instead). He also does a great job of teach workflow: which Photoshop tools to use in what sequence; and you get to practice what he's showing you using the exact same images he's using in the book (Scott provides link to download site). Scott has the gift of being a really good teacher, I love all his books, will buy more in the future, gladly recommend to others.
