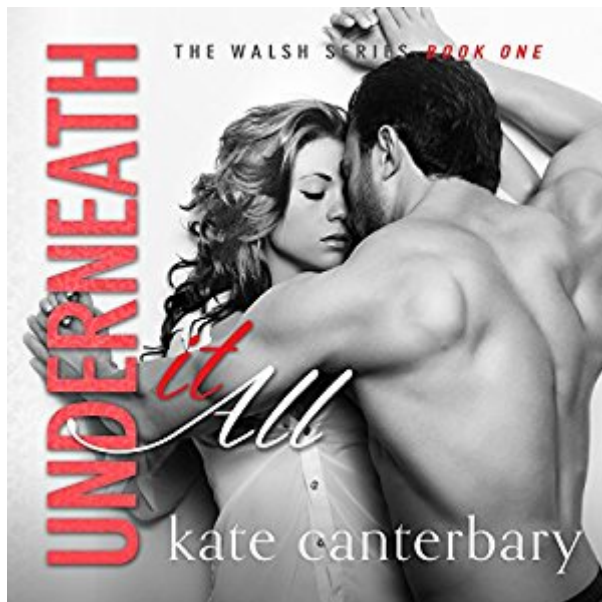

Underneath it All (Walsh Series Book 1) Kate Canterbury This book is probably my favorite of the Walsh series so far. I loved the humor that rolls off the pages while Matt and Lauren struggle to find their way. It was supposed to be a one night stand. It ends up being so much more. Their journey to get there is hot, hilarious, sexy, and occasionally sad. The writing is spot on. The interactions between the Walsh siblings are so damn well written, the trauma that is Angus is horrifying and oppressive. Kate draws you in from the very first line and doesn't let you go until the very end, when you put the book down, disbelieving that it's over and yearning for more. This book is so fantastic I have actually read it three times before I realized I haven't written a review. One of my favorite parts in this book is when Lauren is

thinking to herself about the state of her love life or lack thereof just prior to meeting Matthew: *“I have a hand an incredible group of friends, and a number of vibrators powerful enough to chip a tooth if not handled with care. There was no room in my life for men right now, no need to make room.”* There are numerous hidden gems like that one throughout the book. It really is worth the time to read this and get lost in Boston with the hot architect and the naughty school teacher.

These two had sizzling chemistry given that they were not what the other person was looking for at the time. Matthew had a different type and Lauren was waiting for a different time. Matt is always the guy who mediates and tries to be the neutral third party given the craziness of his family life. He's solid, dependable and ambitious. Lauren is also ambitious, along with independent and moving at 90 miles per hour. She keeps her emotions locked tight, but isn't afraid to get lost in some physical escape. I adored how much Matt tried to anchor her down and keep her close despite Lauren's attempts to maintain distance. I thought Lauren had a good reason for this so it was a little anticlimactic to realize that she didn't have some deep seated fear or buried past that kept her from pursuing more, it was simply the chaos of her life, which made it all the more frustrating. I could understand her drive to succeed, but kind of wanted to shake her, too. I was also intrigued by Matt's siblings and look forward to reading more about each of them because there's

still so much to learn about the family dynamics.

I need more. Those were my immediate thoughts as soon as I finished the audio, which I devoured. It normally takes me on average a week to listen to a book, during my commutes. But this book, I would find excuses to go places, or listen to this book instead of reading. The narrators were spot on, and are now in my top favorites - I will be listening to all the books! Matthew was a pure, hot, alpha male. He was completely swoon-worthy for me and it was delicious. I adored how he wanted to swoop in and save the day. His love for his family made my heart pitter pat.
