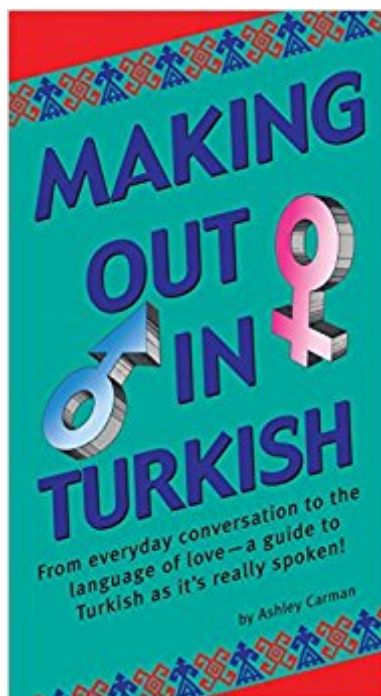

Making Out in Turkish is a fun, accessible and thorough Turkish phrase book and guide to the Turkish language as it's really spoken. Sana hayranım! Seni tekrar ne zaman göreceğim? (I adore you! When can I see you again?) Answer this correctly in Turkish and you may be going on a hot date. Incorrectly, and you could be hurting someone's feelings or getting a slap! Turkish classes and textbooks tend to spend a lot of time rehearsing for the same fictitious scenarios but chances are while in Turkey you will spend a lot more time trying to make new friends or start new romances – something you may not be prepared for. If you are a student, businessman or tourist traveling to Turkey and would like to have an authentic and meaningful experience, the key is being able to speak like a local. This friendly and easy-to-use Turkish phrasebook makes this possible. Making Out in Turkish has been carefully designed to act as a guide to modern colloquial Turkish for use in everyday informal interactions – giving access to the sort of catchy Turkish expressions that aren't covered in traditional language materials. Each expression is given in authentic Turkish (turkce) so that in the case of difficulties the book can be shown to the person the user is trying to communicate with. In addition, phonetic spellings are also included making speaking Turkish a breeze. For example "Okay" – Tamam, is also given as ta-MAHM. This Turkish phrasebook includes: A guide to pronouncing Turkish words correctly. Explanations of basic Turkish grammar, such as, double letters, vowel harmony, agglutination, questions, and negation. Complete Turkish translations including phonetic spellings. Useful and interesting notes on Turkish language and culture. Lots of colorful, fun and useful expressions not covered in other phrasebooks. Making Out in Turkish is a fun little phrase book that gives you some phrases that most books don't cover (at least I certainly don't recall books like Berlitz covering talk about avoiding pregnancy). It is more for getting to know people in less formal situations, and of course more intimate situations and as such probably isn't the only phrase book that you want to have. However if you are looking to spend any time speaking Turkish outside of business situations I would say that this is a good book to have. Not to say that this book doesn't cover the basics of the language any less than other 'pocket' sized books, it just has a different focus, it doesn't cover things that say a person there on business would use, like getting a taxi or finding a bank. If you are going over to live for a time as an exchange student or something it would probably come in very handy. It has such phrases as - Don't talk like an idiot, I'm kidding, Cool, My mouth is on fire, how do you eat this? Can we still be friends?

This book is for more than just making out. Most of the words and phrases are for general situations, not just relationship situations. Really only the last few chapters are devoted to relationship language. You will find this a very useful phrase book. Phrase books are not only for

those who only want to get by in a language. They are also good, and actually almost essential, for those who aim for fluency. They can help get you using the language with natives early on, and that is the key to achieving fluency. You can study grammar books, take courses, and even get a degree in a language and somehow still not know some of the most practical, everyday phrases. This book is a good start.

It has some crucial information in there--very handy phrases & everything you probably ever wanted to know for a relationship and friendships and marriage, dealing with strangers and for the general tourist. Now I need to find one for business--and learn it, of course. This book is not for kids and is complete with swear words and some explicit language. I bought a 10 lesson series and none of it was in this book.
