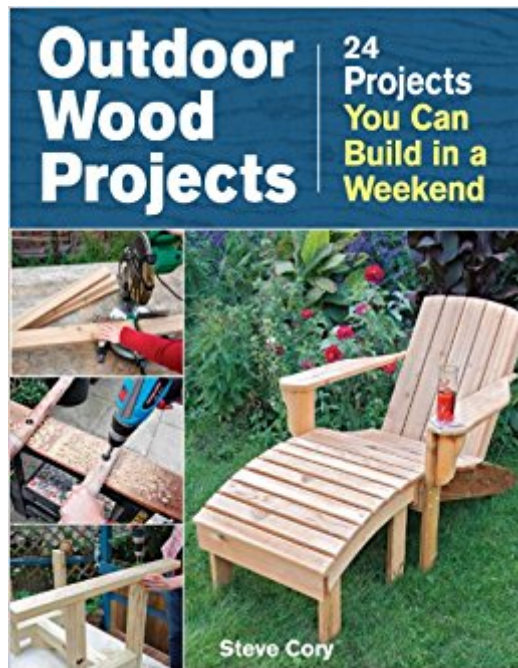

Do not waste your money, this book has a bunch of useless projects. That is why when you ask for samples they only give you the history of the writer which can not help on making the right decision. The only reason I give a star, is because it is the only way that I was allowed to post my disappointment with this book.

Which is not to say it is 'bad,' only to say that if you want to make something innovative or very interesting, you probably should look elsewhere or design it yourself. Still, it is a good book for a slightly advanced beginner, or someone who is not confident in designing their own project. The strawberry pyramid gets the three stars here--that one is pretty clever, and a design I'll be 'riffing' on--the clarity of illustration and instruction gets the fourth.

My son in law (who enjoys woodworking) likes the projects in the book, though he always adds his own modifications and doesn't follow the processes exactly, he says the basics are decent for any carpenter.
