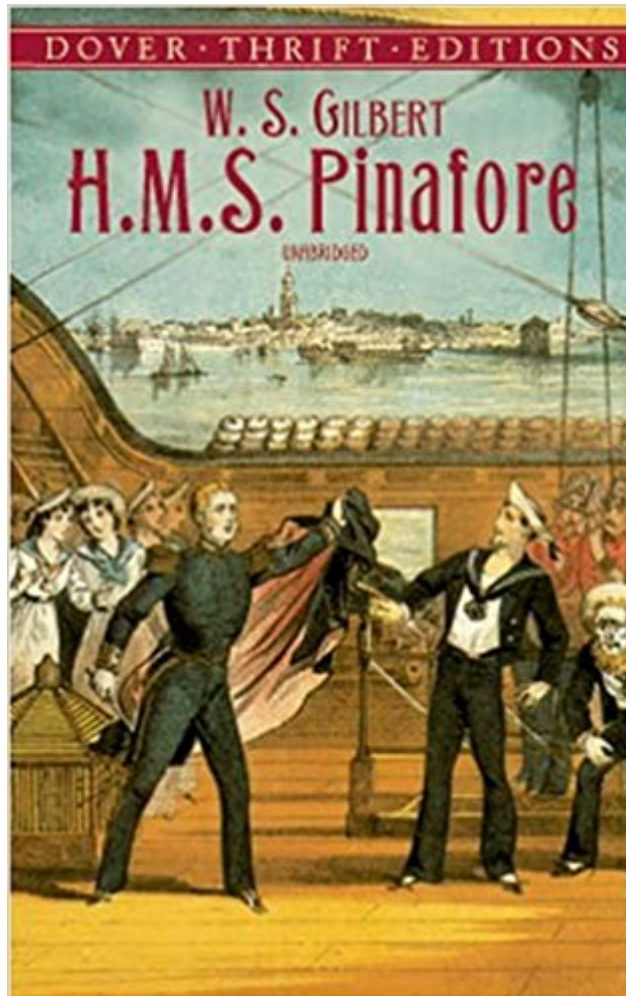

While not what I expected, it was fun to overview operetta in pure story form, and helps with some character development for our upcoming production.

The Schirmer edition of the G&S operas are generally considered to be the definitive versions. The good of it is that they faithfully reproduce the scripts and the binding tends to be good. The bad of it is that they reproduce it verbatim, including all known errata, in a form identical to what has been out of copyright for decades, and with no additional material clarifying terminology or discussing aspects of the production.
