

I think the authors were probably trying to update this book with color and other changes. Yet I believe the original book actually worked better for the very young pianist. That primer allowed the child to color. It also had less artwork so it was more focused on the lesson at hand. I find students in this book are so distracted by the color and artwork that I have to keep redirecting them. So, I've now opted to use this as a supplemental book (for those who have it) and I no longer use it when I'm teaching new students.

Confusing and not well written. Boring to learn with.

Been teaching kids for many years and Bastien is hands down the best method for introducing kids to reading music. Would recommend for anyone up to 11-12 years old! Love this series!

I'm just not a fan of Bastien method. I've all but stopped using it at all. There is too much time spent on staff-less notation. The colors, pictures, and songs are okay, just wish they got to standard notation quicker.

Bought this and the other primer level books for my 7 yr old daughter who wants to learn piano. Her teacher recommend we get these and start with these so she can practice at home. She does very well with all the books that we got her. Very easy to follow. I am musically inclined and I play many instruments, however piano is not one of them. So the books are great to have around if you want to teach yourself a little more and learn with your kids. I have definitely learned a little more myself while helping my daughter to practice. As she continues to grow musically I am sure we will follow with the series. As always, with anything that requires practice, this will only help you to learn and to expand your knowledge. I know many use the Alfred method for beginning piano, but I find Bastien much better all around. It

is straight forward with hand positions so parents can help their children (even if they don't play themselves). It moves ahead step-by-step and in no rush. I appreciate this because not only must teachers teach how to read the music and strike the correct key, but after that is accomplished, then help the student hold his body, hands and hammer correctly. It takes time and short, easy pieces help to make it all come together.
