

Needless to say, once taped the robots don't perform as nicely. Hopefully the book will outlast the children's interest!

My 2-year old son loves listening to the free song while following along with the robots in the book

(instructions to listen to it online are included). The pop-outs are great quality so can handle some "abuse" from being used by a not-so-gentle toddler. But not too much abuse - so you have to supervise them. Really fun song. He laughs whenever the robot jumps and beeps.
