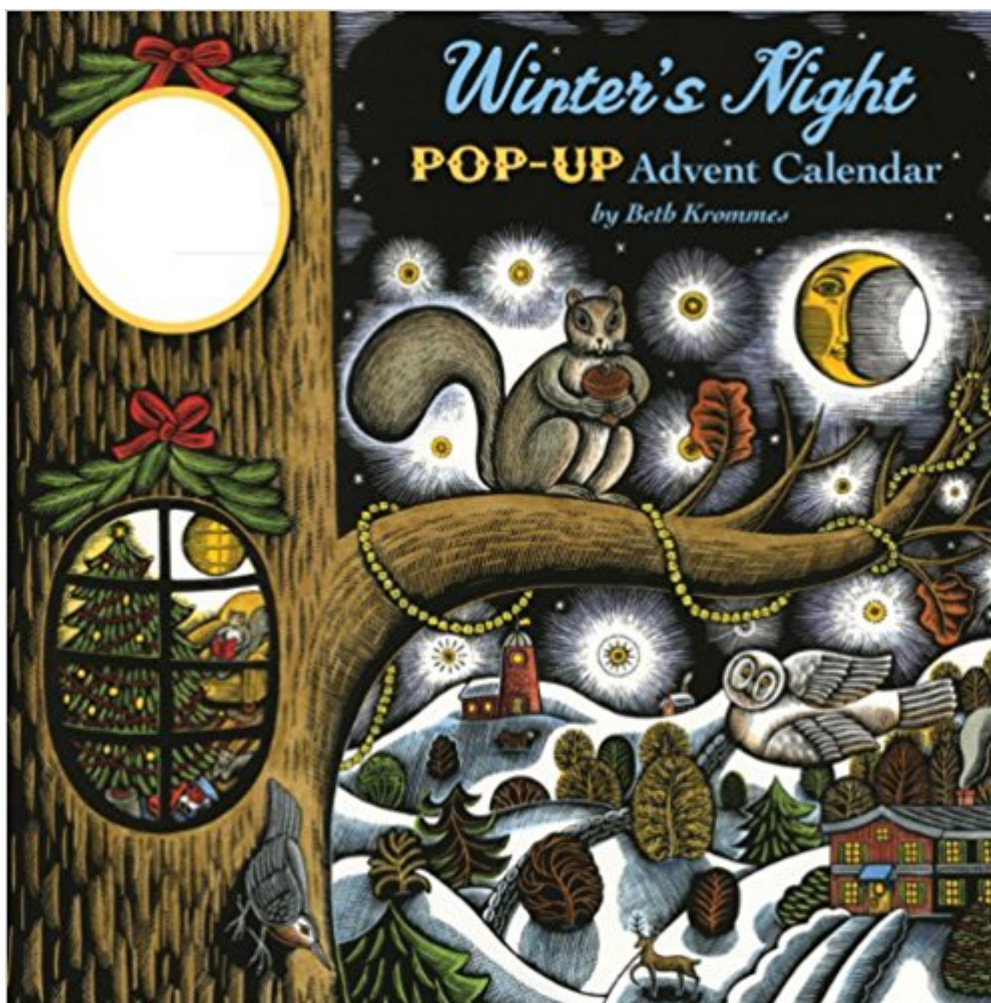


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Winter's Night Pop-Up Advent Calendar

Beth Krommes won the Caldecott Medal in 2009 for her illustrations in *The House in the Night*. She lives in Peterborough, New Hampshire.

This calendar is gorgeous. Each new day of Advent there is a new sticker to be placed on the Winter Christmas scene. Most of the stickers are simple things like additional stars for the sky or some trees for the landscape. We were always more excited when we got an animal or something more exciting. I used it with my just-turned-three year old. It took a few days to get the idea across that we only open one date each day, but it was a nice way work on delay of gratification and to build some anticipation about the season. One of the prettiest advent calendars I've seen.

Because we are big *House in the Night* fans, I had to get this beautiful advent calendar for my two year old son. He is a big fan of stickers, and I wanted to avoid chocolate, so I figured this would be perfect. We both love it and look forward each morning to getting our new sticker. My son takes way longer than I ever imagined to place the sticker and most often it ends up in some completely nonsensical place, but I'm learning to be okay with that:)For a toddler the calendar is a bit on the

fragile side: the pop-up tree doesn't do a good job of staying in place under his rough handling, and I have to be vigilant about watching him with it, because he could easily tear it. But that's just how things go if you have a toddler. Definitely better for slightly older kids in this sense. I know a lot of people complained about lack of variety in the stickers (lots of stars). I'll just say that we are on day nine and have yet to get more than one star. Not sure what the next two weeks will hold. The only other thing I can say is that a lot of stars does make sense, since the winter night sky is filled with them.

I was looking for a non religious, non candy advent calendar. This is beautifully illustrated. My son loves placing a new sticker on the woodland scene each day. Its simple and inexpensive. I highly recommend.

I search for alternative choices to the chocolate type calendars as I have a daughter that is a vegan. This is a colorful "record album" size piece of art that each day you can add to. My kids are teens, and they still enjoyed this design and concept. The tree pops forward and stands, and you fold the front down to open up each day to find the sticker.

I got this both for my nieces and for my own family, wondering exactly what it was... and everybody loves it! It's beautifully illustrated, and it's good fun to figure out where to place each day's sticker.

I'm very picky when it comes to Advent calendars for the grandchildren. I wanted an alternative to the chocolate/Disney/Hallmark brand you find at the store. The illustrations are outstanding and it's a excellent way to teach children how to count down for the big celebration. It's only a few dollars more than the generic and twice as nice!

Beautifully illustrated. Great that it has no chocolate but still exciting for little ones. The pop ups are somewhat hard for little fingers and it is NOT a wall advent. It is meant to sit on a table.
