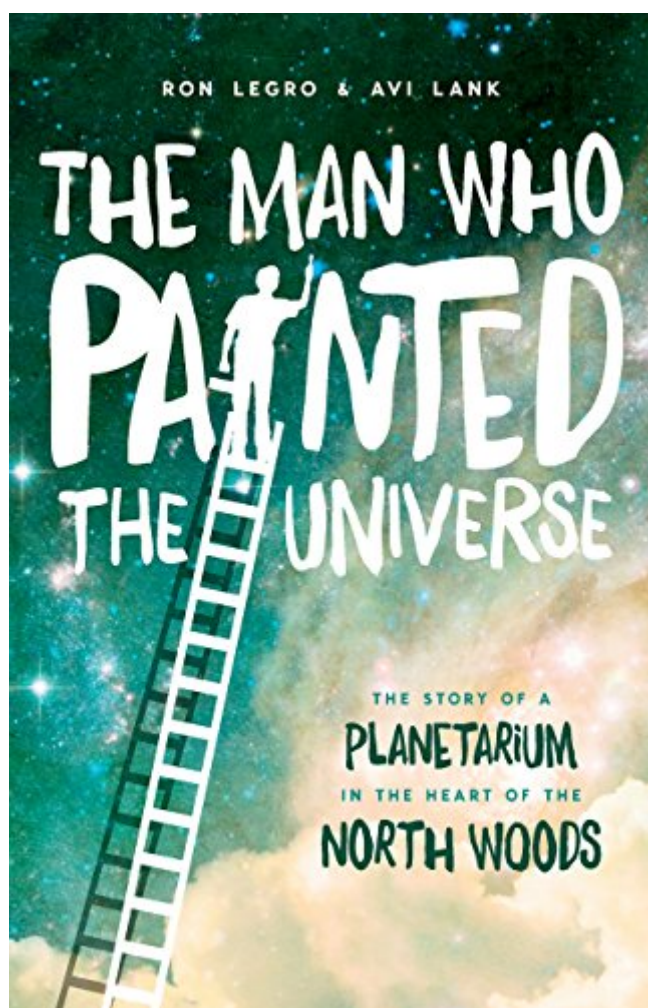


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The Man Who Painted The Universe: The Story Of A Planetarium In The Heart Of The North Woods
