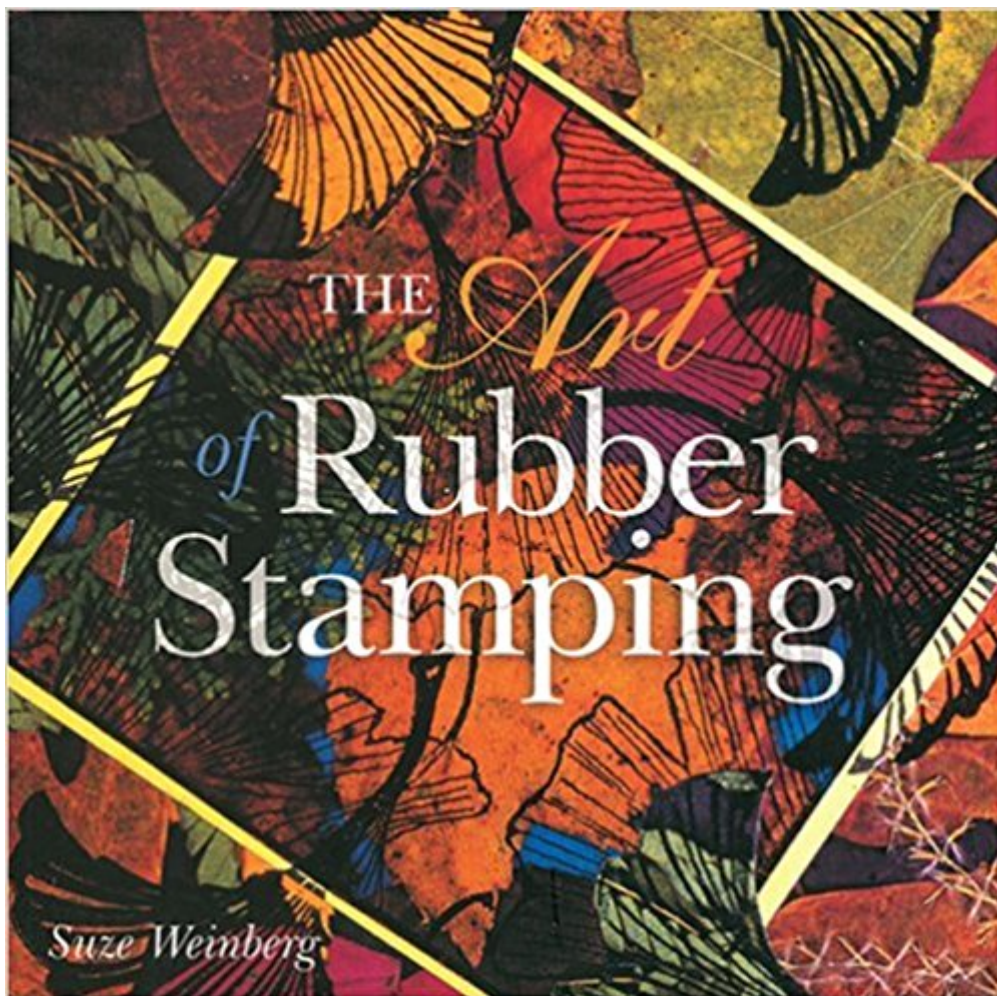

There are so many amazing ideas in this book. However I would say there is only maybe 75% usefulness as to technique.this is not just about stamps and ink techniques. There is some how to, but for the most part it’s an look book. If you are competent in using the media theyv are refering to you may have no problem taking your own steps from the ideas and going to town. But I’m not well versed on alcohol ink, resist, clays and metal. But it really is a great book to look forward to increasing your artist skill.

I was excited to order the book, but once I opened it up and read through it I was disappointed. As an experienced stamper, I found several techniques, such as embossing ink resist, polished stone, and ultra thick embossing enamel old hat. I was hoping for more innovative techniques. I would also have appreciated seeing several cards broken down from start to finish instead of just quick hits on techniques. Complete projects would be helpful for the less advanced stampers. That is the audience I think would most benefit from this book. Some of the card samples are beautiful, but too many seem amateurish and poorly composed. Suze Weinberg is a talented and innovative artist, but this showcase is not her best work. All in all, this book was nice to thumb through, but not worth the cost.

This book could have greatly benefitted from the proper crediting of images used and indication of the paper artist providing the examples. Anyone wishing to find the source of a given image used will be frustrated. Although there is a listing of stamp companies with a summary of the pages showing their images, it's impossible to determine which company provided which image on a given page showing multiple stamps. FRUSTRATING. The techniques illustrated are mostly old, well-known processes which any paper artist well versed in the current 'stuff' will be familiar with and many of the tricks to success with these techniques are omitted. A cursory summary at best for most techniques with sketchy documentation. I did get a couple new ideas but could easily have passed on this book if I'd seen a copy before ordering. I highly recommend that those interested in this type of paper arts book consider the three marvelous books by Mary Jo McGraw instead.

This book is a wonderful pictorial of Rubber Stamping techniques. It has beautiful pictures, easy to understand instructions, and detailed supply lists. It's a must read for every serious stamper.
