

His lasting themes include Platonic love, the theory of forms, the five regimes, innate knowledge, among others. This Kindle edition of Plato contains (as far as I can tell) all of the definitely genuine dialogues of Plato, as well as some of the spurious (meaning probably fake) dialogues. The edition also does not seem to contain any of Plato's letters (most of which are considered spurious). I have read through most of the dialogues (up to the "late works") and I have enjoyed them very much, and would recommend them to anyone interested. Most of the translations are by Benjamin Jowett, and many of the dialogues include introductions and/or essays by him. I found the translations to be excellent, and cannot imagine their having been any better. My primary complaint with this edition is the large number of misspellings and errors in punctuation, which apparently resulted in the process of converting the works to a digital format. These errors become especially noticeable in the later dialogues, and while they never become intolerable, they are certainly a major oversight on the part of the publisher. Overall, this edition has good translations and all the genuine dialogues, but many typos. P.S. If, while reading, you feel like Parmenides is the most difficult text you've ever encountered, don't give up! Just keep pushing through, getting out of it as much as you can-- I don't think anyone really understands it!

It is amazing to have this collection available for such a small price. Highly recommended!
